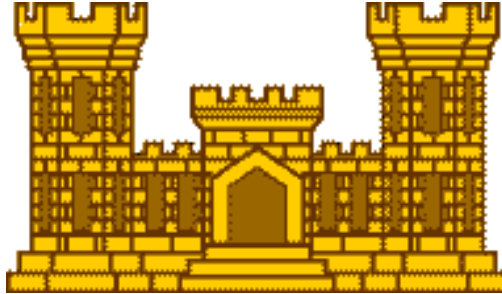

OVERVIEW

The AEA Congressman David L. Hobson STEM Scholarship award is sponsored by Trimble, a leading provider of advanced positioning solutions that maximize productivity and enhance profitability.

Each year -- completed applications and supporting documentation must be mailed to arrive at AEA no later than 30 April.

Awards will be evaluated and announced by 30 June

Up to two awards of \$3000 each may be presented each year at the discretion of AEA.

Scholarship applicants must meet the following criteria to be eligible:

- United States Citizen
- Current AEA member or a family member of a current AEA member
- Full time undergraduate student at an accredited university or college
- Pursuing a baccalaureate degree in STEM
- Completed application, essay and two sealed letters of recommendation
