





Article Submission Program Guidelines

The focus of this program is to highlight the relationships and support of Army missions and engineering throughout the world. Articles should have a specific engineering or Army interest. When possible first-hand accounts in support of Army engineering should be included. Articles should be about 1000 words or less. Articles should be written in such a manner to be consistent with the normal editorial content of the magazine and clearly not focused on directly “advertising” a specific product or service. Materials should avoid overuse of self-promotional phrases. All submissions must be readable as articles so please properly edit scholarly/educational paper to make sure they read as an article.

All article particulars are at the discretion of the editor. No fees are paid to authors for any work submitted.

Please provide:

-  Hi-Res photos with photographer credits and captions. Photos need to be sent separately even if they are included in article.
-  Videos or YouTube links to videos (if desired).
-  Author’s two to three sentence bio that includes current title, duties, duty station and etc.
-  Graphics (if desired) that are eye-catching.
